Nominees must currently be in training or within five years of having completed training (PhD/Medical Residency/Fellowship) to be eligible for a Presidential Prize.

- The nomination letter (1 page in length and addressed to the Secretary-General, ISL) from an active ISL member.
- Submitted abstract(s).
- Abbreviated curriculum vitae of the nominee (maximum 2 pages)
